STORM READINESS CHECKLIST

TAKE INVENTORY OF YOUR SITUATION AND KNOW WHAT'S AT RISK

	Identify any equipment stored outdoors. Review equipment scheduled for transport.	wind, or debris—to include locations where equipment is being shipped and stored.
INSF	PECT CURRENT PROTECTION	
	Are existing tarps torn, loose, or waterlogged?	Are your current covers, tarps, or shrink wrap securely fastened?
	Are there signs of rust, corrosion, or water intrusion on equipment?	
EVA	LUATE YOUR EQUIPMENT NEEDS	
	Does the equipment have sensitive electronics or components?	Do you need quick access (zipper door), airflow (vents), or transport durability?
	Will it be stored long-term or shipped during storm season?
